Assessment	Formative assessment: at the end of each lesson student are asked to work in group or individually on a worksheet with charts to fill or matching definitions, or to perform a speaking giving instruction.Summative assessment: children are asked to answer a kahoot multiple choice quiz about geography at half term of course, and at the end of course they are going to elaborate multiple choice questions about Sardinia's History and geography, in order to create a kahoot quiz.Other types of contents and culture tests are: filling a chart about Sardinia history timeline, open questions about Sennori cultural aspects, fill in the blanks about Italy geographical features. Most relevant assessment is going to be children performing during the "Monumenti Aperti" event.Final self assessment: children will be invited to evaluate their own work (Children's self-assessment) and their group work.
